WAYNE TOWNSHIP BOARD ELECTS LEADERS FOR 2023

INDIANAPOLIS – On Tuesday, at a special organizational meeting, the Wayne Township Board selected its officers for the 2023 year. The following members were elected:

- Bryan Chatfield, District 3, was re-elected as the chair of the Wayne Township Board. A non-profit leader, Chatfield has served as a member of the Wayne Township Board since 2021 and as its chair since 2022.
- Ramona Ward, District 5, was elected to serve at the board's Vice Chair. Previously serving as Board Secretary, Ward is a long-time community leader who was first elected in 2021.
- Doris Minton-McNeill, District 4, was elected as the Wayne Township Board Secretary. Minton-McNeill, who served on the board from 2007 to 2008 and returned in 2018, has served as Secretary in earlier terms.

The board is made up of five individuals who are elected to four-year terms and represent a specific geographic area, or district, of the township. Board members are responsible for providing oversight of the township, including approving budgets, authorizing capital expenditures, and ensuring the township government is operating efficiently. Board members also represent their constituents at a variety of public and private events and serve as a resource to assist residents in accessing township services.

"We are grateful for the continued service of all our board members, especially those who stepped into these leadership roles," said Jeb Bardon, Wayne Township Trustee. "This year will be about bringing positive change and progress to Wayne Township government and I look forward to partnering with the board to make that happen."

Located on Indianapolis' west side, Wayne Township is home to nearly 150,000 residents, vibrant neighborhoods, hundreds of businesses and important assets like the Indianapolis Motor Speedway and the Indianapolis International Airport.
