



Basic Necessary Living Expenses Section III-20 (IC 12-7-2-20.5)

Basic necessities are defined, for the purpose of the Township Assistance Administration, as those services or items essential to meet the minimum standards of health, safety, and decency, such as the following:

- Shelter (rent or mortgage)
- Essential Utility Services
- Food
- Household supplies
- Medical
- Transportation to work and seek/accept employment.

The following is a list of items that are not considered essential and will be considered as wasted resources. It's by no means exhaustive, but it covers the main areas.

- Holiday Purchases including birthdays.
- Credit Card Payments
- Bank Fees
- Loan repayments
- Restaurants/Fast Food/ Door Dash/Grub Hub
- All court-probation-parole-detention-drug/alcohol program costs
- Cable/Satellite
- Storage Units
- Furniture/ Appliance Rental
- Alcohol/drugs/cigarettes
